# **Clarity Omnibus Survey**

August 2023


The August 2023 Clarity Omnibus Survey was conducted from August 10-16, 2023 via national online public opinion panels and 2,018 respondents were matched to the voter file. The margin of error of this poll is +/- 1.36% at a 95% confidence interval.

Attention checks were employed in the survey and respondents who failed attention check questions were removed from the sample.


Responses are weighted to a national universe of likely voters using factors including age, gender, race, education, and geography.








Given these options, how would you prefer to vote in the next election?





In the 2024 primary election for President in your state, are you more likely to:











#### If the 2024 Presidential election was being held today, who would you vote for?

Do you think of yourself as a Republican, a Democrat, or an Independent?






[After Independent Push] Do you think of yourself as a Republican, a Democrat, or an Independent?










Which of the following issues is most important to you when deciding who to vote for?












Do you currently have health insurance coverage? If yes, what type?



How often do you attend religious services?


















Do you primarily make and receive calls on a mobile phone, landline phone, or both about equally?








How frequently do you check your mailbox and look at the mail you receive?










[IF has traditional TV services] How frequently would you say that you watch traditional television?
