# Clarity Omnibus Survey

February 2023

### Methodology

The February 2023 Clarity Omnibus Survey was conducted from February 14 - 20, 2023 via national online public opinion panels and 2,002 respondents were matched to the voter file. The margin of error of this poll is +/- 2.15% at a 95% confidence interval.


Attention checks were employed in the survey and respondents who failed attention check questions were removed from the sample.

Responses are weighted to a national universe of likely voters using factors including age, gender, race, education, and geography.



Do you think things in the United States are going in the right direction or do you think we're on the wrong track?




Generally speaking, how much do you trust these institutions or groups to act in the best interest of people like you?







Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of ...




Do you approve or disapprove of the job ... is doing?




[IF registered to vote] If the election were today for the U.S. House of Representatives, would you vote for the Republican or Democratic candidate for Congress?






Our **Early Vote Preference Model** predicts an individual's preference to cast their vote prior to Election Day. <u>Learn more</u>.


How confident are you that, across the country, the votes will be accurately cast and counted in the next election?



In the 2020 election for President, for whom did you vote?




Do you think of yourself as a Republican, a Democrat, or an Independent?






Which of the following statements best characterizes your view of climate change and environmental issues?


As you may know, our federal government is currently facing a budget deficit. Which of the following is closer to your view?






For statistical purposes only, do you or does anyone in your house own a gun?


Do you have a degree from a four-year college?





On an average day, how many total hours do you spend using social media such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter or other platforms?





On an average day, how many total hours of television do you watch?




Our Low TV Model predicts likelihood that an individual watches little to no TV and is difficult to reach via television advertising. Learn more.

Which of the following best describes your access to online TV streaming services?






Do you have traditional TV service in your home?



[IF has traditional TV service] How many times a week would you say that you watch traditional television? For example, sports, game shows, TV shows on networks like ABC or NBC, or your local news?




Thinking more about your media consumption, please rank the following list in order from the MOST time spent to the least (or no) time spent on a weekly basis.


